The City of Riverside Board of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing to consider the modifications to its Water Rates (but is not proposing increases to its rates), as follows:

1. To amend Water Rate Schedules WA-1 Residential Metered Service, WA-2 Flat Rate-Temporary Service, WA-3 Irrigation Metered Service, WA-4 Riverside Water Company Irrigators, WA-5 Fire Protection Services and Fire Hydrants, WA-6 General Metered Service, WA-7 Special Metered Service, WA-8 Greenbelt Irrigation Service, WA-9 Grove Preservation Service, and WA-10 Recycled Water Service to incorporate language to state the Water General Fund Transfer is a component of every customer's water bill, and is a transfer of up to 11.5% of revenues from the Water Fund to the City's General Fund. On June 4, 2013, the voters of the City of Riverside approved the Water General Fund Transfer as a general tax, pursuant to Article 13.C of the California Constitution.

Customers wishing to comment on the proposed actions should attend this meeting, or forward written protests to the Public Utilities General Manager at 3750 University Ave, 5th Floor, Riverside, CA 92501, prior to the hearing.
